- French House Red** Soft, fruity with a muscular texture. Been down the gym? 4.30 / 5.90 / 16.50
- Cotes du Rhone, Remy Febras** (Grenache, Syrah) The old tunes are always the best, this is "red, red wine"! 5.70 / 7.90 / 22.00
- Beaujolais Village, Domaine du Sabot** (Gamay) Refreshingly light, packed with juicy summer fruit, it's bright & youthful. Just like you. £26.00
- Hauts de Castlemare Corbières** (Grenache, Syrah & Carignan) Ripe damson jam & cassis with the aroma of heather & wild thyme. Great stuff from the South of France £27.00
- Organic Fleurie, Cote des Labourons** (Gamay) Flowery & fragrant, packed with cherry fruit. A very attractive wine in a silk dress. £28.00
- Bordeaux Supérieur, Château Recougne** (Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot & Carménère) Full of ripe black fruit, with hints of smokey mocha & toast. Robust & savoury. Classic Claret style. £25.00
- Chateauneuf du Pape, Phillippine Saint-Cyrille** (Grenache, Syrah, Mourvedre) Warm, spicy, smooth and intensely complex. Like the person sitting opposite? £38.00

FRENCH WHITE & ROSÉ WINES

- House White** Not to be sniffed at. It's perfect for drinking. 4.30 / 5.90 / 16.50
- Muscadet, Jean Sablenay** (Melon de Bourgogne) Dry, crisp & refreshing. Best drunk with seafood by the Atlantic Ocean. Failing that, here at Le Mistral. . 5.40 / 7.50 / 21.00
- Le Voyage D'Odette** (Sauvignon Blanc) Fruity exotic tones with hints of citrus and white flowers. Fresh as a daisy. 5.60 / 7.70 / 21.50
- ✔ **Macon - Villages, La Cave d'Azé** (Chardonnay) Fresh, elegant & perfectly balanced tones of fruit and the richness of roasted nuts. Just like a fruit & nut bar, but no chocolate. £26.00
- ✔ **L'abeille Picpoul de Pinet** Young, lively & zesty in character from the deep in the South of France. If you enjoy Pinot or Sauvignon you'll love this. £23.00
- ✔ **Sancerre, Blanc Duc Armand** (Sauvignon Blanc) From the village of Sancerre in the Loire Valley. Many attempt to match the refined quality of wine from here, few achieve it. £34.00
- E Bonneville Chablis** (Chardonnay) Dry, steely, flinty & stylish. The James Bond of wines. £34.00

- ✔ **Blush Zinfandel, Gufetto** (Italy) Sun drenched, sweet, sexy & naughty. This Italian version knocks the socks of the Californian stuff 4.90 / 6.80 / 19.00
- ✔ **Pinot Grigio Rosé, Ombrellino** (Italy) A blushing smooth Italian smoocher 5.00 / 6.70 / 19.90
